Dear friends,

Some comments (and by no means exhaustive) on the Sacrament of Confession.

For many hundreds of years people have gone to the Sacrament of Confession for healing and for the renewal of their lives.

The sacred confidentiality of confession has meant that people felt safe in sharing sometimes very difficult aspects of their lives.

For a priest to be able to give absolution he needs to be convinced that the person going to confession is sincere in their resolve to avoid repeating the same sin.

It is a common experience that paedophiles do not go to confession since they do not believe that they are doing something wrong. Would a paedophile confess if he believed that the priest would go to the police?

We of course have zero tolerance for the abuse or neglect of children. Priests are, and uphold, being mandatory notifiers. In fact our Church institutions and schools are at present among the safest places for children because of procedures that have been put in place.

If in the hypothetical case of a paedophile coming to confession, the priest could at least have some possibility of making a positive intervention and even withhold absolution if they do not take steps to get help. This will in effect then mean that the law will also become aware of the situation. They certainly would not come if they knew that they would be reported to the police.
