Just a reminder that all children need to be accompanied to and from the toilet, ideally by an adult family member. Please ensure that children are supervised in the carpark at all times.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

You will be aware that Archbishop Wilson was sentenced today to a non-parole period of imprisonment of six months with an additional period of six months to be served on parole. The proceedings have been adjourned until August 14 during which time he will be assessed for suitability for home detention.

It is therefore inappropriate that I make any further comment on the case at this stage.

However, in such circumstances we should be very aware of the impact on survivors, their families and all those who love them. I have witnessed the anguish and grief of victims. The Church must continue all efforts to listen and support them.

The arrangements made by Pope Francis for my care of the Archdiocese as Apostolic Administrator remain in place. Please be assured that our commitment to the safety of every child and vulnerable person in our Church and schools is paramount. We will never let anything shift our resolve in this regard.
