## St Mary Magdalene

Pope Francis has called St Mary Magdalene an Apostle to the Apostles. Jesus first appears to her on Easter Sunday morning. She recognises him when he calls her by name. Jesus had freed Mary Magdalene from spiritual oppression and opened her up to the amazing love of God for her. She who had been forgiven much, loved much.

During the terrible, horrific crucifixion, Mary was there at the foot of the Cross. Now Jesus first comes to her, in this moment of glory in the new life of resurrection. She is the first eye-witness of the Resurrection and is sent to proclaim this amazing good news to the leaders of the Christian community, the Apostles.

Like Mary Magdalene we are called to leave behind us the self appreciation and confusion that comes with sin.

Because of Jesus we are able to share in his Resurrection and victory over evil and all manner of confusion. We are able to be indeed people of hope. Our life needs to be good news for others. We are called to be witnesses to the Resurrection. As we face personal problems, family issues, illness, death, grief and anything else, we are reminded by the Resurrection that Jesus is always with us, never abandoning us.

By living out this faith in our everyday lives, indeed we become living reminders that Christ is risen, but there is always hope for all.
