Temporary Changes in October

During October there will be some unavoidable changes in the parish programme of weekday Masses and Confessions. Last weekend **Fr Tony Telford-Sharp** took up his appointment as parish priest of Blackwood-Belair and **Fr Peter Dunn** continues to be on extended sick leave. From the 1st to the 19th October I will be leading a pilgrimage to the Holy Land and Paray-le-Monial (where **St Margaret Mary** received revelations of the Heart of Jesus). I have been committed to this pilgrimage months before I came to the Cathedral. From Monday 22nd to Thursday 25th October, all the priests and deacons of the Archdiocese will be attending an Assembly at the Passionist Monastery. All of this leaves the parish in a difficult situation.

While we have the generous support of some retired priests, the chaplain to the Korean community and the parish priest from the Syro-Malabhar Community, it will be necessary to have Liturgy of the Word with Holy Communion in place of some weekday Masses during October. Confession times will be disrupted in the week beginning the 22nd. I am sure that you will all be understanding of this reality. All Sunday Masses will be covered during the month.
