## Australian Catholic Plenary Council



The first session of this ground breaking Council will be held in Adelaide in 2020. We are in the initial stage of **listening** when Catholics and other interested people can contribute their ideas, hopes, needs to help shape the **future of the Church in Australia**. This listening time means that every voice and every hope is important. There will be a host of ideas across the whole range of people's thoughts.

There will be **big issues** which will be found across the nation, but there are the **small ideas** which only a few may raise, but which will, nonetheless, be very important for the Church to hear and respond to.

This Council has a focus on being very pastoral, where the voice of the lay faithful is loud and clear. A learning time for our bishops and others in leadership roles.

The Parish Team, the Parish Pastoral Council, with the Christian Life Committees, will continue to work on this and prepare for a number of parish **'listening events'** to encourage more parishioners to be involved. These will take place in November.
