Social Justice Sunday

On the last Sunday of September, since the 1940s, the Catholic Church in Australia has observed Social Justice Sunday. The theme this year – addressing a growing crisis in Australia – is on homelessness: **A Place to Call Home – Making a Home for Everyone in Our Land**. Free copies of the statement are available at all of the churches in the parish.

The statement offers us **10 Steps to making a home for everyone**.

Reflect on the parable of the **Good Samaritan** – Luke Get the **facts** about homelessness and the housing crisis. See 2016 census – www.abs.gov.au

Reach out to people experiencing housing difficulties and homelessness – buy a copy of The Big Issue.

Understand the bigger picture behind the housing crisis.

Make our parishes and communities **welcoming places**.

Take action to support housing initiatives and programmes.

Advocate for change locally and nationwide Help **combat misunderstanding** and misrepresentation.

Remember: **Standing with those in need is central to our faith**.
