Bishop Charles Gauci DD

Today we welcome Bishop Charles back to the Cathedral for the 11am Mass to give thanks for his Ordination as Bishop of Darwin last Wednesday night, and to make our parish farewell to him.

Bishop Charles takes to Darwin his experience of 40 years as a priest in Adelaide.

He began his ministry in Mater Dei Parish at Woodville and spent many years as parish priest of Elizabeth and then at Noarlunga Downs. At various times he was a member of the Council of Priests, the College of Consultors and the Appointments Board for Priests. Associated with the Confraternity of Christian Doctrine, he is also an experienced Spiritual Director.

His energy and love of nature, his skill at gardening and cooking will, combined with his faith, equip him well for his new ministry which will cover the Northern Territory.

We pray that the Holy Spirit will be with him and the people of the Diocese of Darwin as together they build up the Kingdom of God in faith, justice and charity. We congratulate Bishop Charles on his Ordination, thank him for his ministry in our parish, and pray for him in his new ministry with heavy responsibilities.

Synod of Bishops: Young People, Faith and Vocational Discernment

On last Tuesday the 15th Ordinary Synod of Bishops began at the Vatican. Its theme is **Young People, Faith, and Vocational Discernment**. It is being attended by over 300 bishops, most appointed by their peers in their own countries, as well as a representative group of young adults from around the world.

There has been an extensive preparation for this Synod during which youth and young adults have been able to share their hopes for the Church, their disappointments with the Church and their struggles in the world today.

The energy of youth has always been essential for the life of the Church. They have given us so many inspirational Saints. So many works of the Church were begun by the youth of the Church – Mary MacKillop in her early 20s founding the Sisters of St Joseph; Frederick Ozanam beginning the St Vincent de Paul Society when he was a University student. Youthful martyrs of the Church in Charles Lwanga and companions in Uganda, and among those in Vietnam, Korea, Philippines, with Peter To Rot in New Guinea.

Francis of Assisi set out to 'renew Christ's Church' as a young man, and Catherine of Siena was challenging the Pope, then living in France, to return to Rome for the good of the Church.

This Synod, under the leadership of Pope Francis, and working with youth, will help discern the lives, faith and vocational discernment of youth and young adults in the world of today. The Church needs their energy, enthusiasm, faith, prayerfulness, sense of justice, care of the earth, compassion for those deprived of rights for the conversion of us all in these difficult times.
