## AUSTRALIAN PLENARY COUNCIL 2020

The Church in Australia is preparing for what is called a Plenary Council –the last one was held in the 1930s. It will be a gathering of the Bishops of Australia with other delegates, to look at the life of the Church in Australia, the hopes and expectations of the people, and the needs of Australia, in an effort to shape a hope-filled and confident future of faith and charity.

Across the nation we are in a period of **listening** when all Catholics can express **freely and without criticism** what is their experience of Church, what are their needs and those of others, and what are their hopes for the Church.

A number of gatherings are planned to open this up to parishioners across the parish, to record what they say and to submit people's hopes to the co-ordinating committee, along with tens of thousands from across Australia.

Every voice is important. Common threads will appear, but also invaluable insights will emerge. This is open to all regardless of age, nationality, sexuality.

The **Parish Pastoral Council** and the local **Christian Life Committees** will gather at Thebarton on **Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> December** with **Sarah Moffett** of Adelaide who is on the National Committee.

## Early Start 11am Masses next Sunday, 11<sup>th</sup> November

Next Sunday is Remembrance Day which this year will mark the **100<sup>th</sup> anniversary** of the end of World War I. Traditionally, at the 11<sup>th</sup> hour of the 11<sup>th</sup> day of the 11<sup>th</sup> month, at the time the peace treaty was signed, a one minute silence of observed.

The 11am Masses at the Cathedral, Holy Name and St Peter Claver, Mass will **start at 3 minutes to 11** with the hymn, in order that at 11am the celebrant will be able introduce the one minute silence for all to observe, remembering the millions of people who died in that terrible war.

## MEMORIAL SERVICE

The annual Memorial Service for parishioners and relatives of parishioners who have died in the last 12 months will be held at **St Peter Claver Church, 8 Stuart Road, Dulwich Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> November at 7pm**. November is our traditional month for praying for the departed, and this Memorial Service gives us an opportunity to remember our recently deceased and for the comforting of their families and friends. This Service is not a Mass, but a liturgy of remembrance. **All are welcome**. The Service will be followed by a light supper in St Peter Claver Hall, across from the Church.

## SHOAH SERVICE

This Annual Diocesan Service, on next **Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> November at 7pm in the Cathedral**, will commemorate the Shoah (Holocaust), in which 6 million Jewish people were killed in concentration camps during World War II. In addition, many other people were killed – Christians, priests and religious, Jehovah Witnesses and homosexuals.

Several Saints of the Church died in the camps – Jewish woman and Carmelite Nun, St Teresa Benedicta (Edith Stein); Franciscan priest, St Maximilian Kolbe; Catholic newspaper editor, Blessed Nicholas Gross.

This Service will bring together people of Christian and Jewish faith, and every year is a most moving service. Come and remember, and pray for peace, and especially where people are being killed or persecuted because of their nationality or religion.
