Death of Monsignor Denis Edwards

We mourn the death of Monsignor Denis Edwards who for the past year has lived at Thebarton and celebrated the weekend and Wednesday Masses at Queen of Angels. Monsignor Denis (he preferred to be called Father) died last Tuesday morning at 5.15am after a stroke on Saturday.

He celebrated his 75th birthday last December. While assisting at Thebarton, Monsignor Denis was a senior lecturer at the Adelaide Campus of the Australian Catholic University. Before that he was a lecturer at the Adelaide Catholic Theological College and the ecumenical Adelaide College of Divinity.

The author of 14 books and numerous articles, extensively on Ecology and Theology, he was a founding member of the International Society for Science and Religion. Fr. Denis chaired the Adelaide Catholic Diocesan Ecumenical and Interfaith Commission for five years and was a member of the Australian Lutheran-Roman Catholic Dialogue. In 2012 he was awarded the Order of Australia Medal for services to the Archdiocese and theological education. He was appointed a Monsignor by Pope Francis in 2015.

Fr Denis was an extraordinary priest, humble and prayerful, compassionate and sensitive. A brilliant teacher of the faith with deep insights. A true man of integrity. All who were touched by his ministry are saddened by his death. We pray comfort for his family and colleagues and for the community at Queen of Angels.

Priests of the Lord, praise the Lord.

Cathedral Parish Scripture Study Program

Our program for this year continues with a study of the Gospel of Luke commencing on 25th March in the Cathedral Hall between 7.30 and 9 pm. The remaining sessions are on April - 1,8,29, May - 13,20,27, June - 3,17,24 July - 1 & 8. Luke tells the story of Jesus of Nazareth as a mighty prophet and Saviour of the world in fulfilment of Old Testament expectations.

Luke also emphasizes Jesus as a person dedicated to prayer. Beginning with Jesus' virginal conception and birth, he follows Jesus through his public ministry to his passion, death, resurrection and ascension into heaven—all under the guidance of the Holy Spirit. Using readings, DVD presentations and group discussions, our program offers participants an opportunity to reflect on and discuss their faith in a supportive environment.

Some "home-work" is required. We invite participants to make any donation that is possible to support this Adult Faith Formation initiative. To help you discern your contribution, we offer two levels of payment to consider; full cost \$27, subsidised cost \$15. Participants should bring a Bible. Project Compassion

The focus is on work in Zimbabwe. A 12 year old girl had to walk 7 kilometres every morning to collect water for herself and her grandparents and then she would go to school exhausted.

Money raised through Project Compassion enables the village to install solar powered pumps and two 10,000 litre water storage tanks. As Thandolwayo says, "Now I can bathe every day. We now drink clean water and diseases are no longer affecting us."

Our individual contributions, gathered together, enable such life changing projects to be established. As Pope Francis says, "The future does have a name ... and it is hope."
