## Reorganising Parish Liturgical/Pastoral Care

Following the death of Monsignor Denis Edwards, there will be a reorganising of the liturgical and pastoral care of parishioners.

**Fr. Peter Rozitis** will celebrate the Vigil and Morning Masses at Queen of Angels, including the monthly Italian Mass. He also has the Diocesan responsibility of Mass for Portuguese speaking people on the 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Sundays of the Month at St. Patrick's in the city. He is also chaplain at the Women's and Children's Hospital, attending on Tuesday and Fridays.

**Fr. My Tran** will celebrate the Sunday Morning Masses at St. Mary's and Holy Name, and alternate with Fr. Rozitis the Sunday evening Cathedral Mass. He is also the priest associate with Calvary Wakefield. He will give pastoral care to those communities.

**Fr. Roy John** will celebrate the Vigil and Morning Masses at St Peter Claver and the Morning Mass at St John Vianney. He will give pastoral care to those communities as well.

**Fr. Francis Tawil** will continue to celebrate the Sunday 7am Mass in the Cathedral.

**Fr. Maurice Shinnick** will celebrate the Vigil and 9am and 11am Morning Masses in the Cathedral. He continues as Acting Administrator of the parish.

All the priests will share weekday Cathedral Masses. With **Fr. Michael McCaffrey FSSP and Fr Adrian Wee FSSP**, the priests will share the Cathedral Confession times as well as being on call for emergency calls to the hospitals in the parish and parishioners. Fr. Adrian will continue his ministry to the housebound.

**Sr. Mary Cresp RSJ** continues as the Pastoral Associate for the Dulwich /Burnside Communities.

**Mrs. Maria Iandanza** continues as the Pastoral Associate for the St. Peters and Thebarton Communities.
