Welcome Monsignor Robert Aitken

This morning we have the joy of welcoming Monsignor Robert Aitken back to the Cathedral to celebrate the Eucharist in thanksgiving as he approaches his 90th birthday on the 25th May. Monsignor's long association, first with the Cathedral as Administrator and then with the then Dulwich/Burnside Parish as Parish Priest, means that his ministry has touched many tens of thousands of people through the decades. Renowned as a preacher, a lover of fine liturgical music, a priest dedicated to the sick and dying, a person of warm hospitality especially towards priests, a great supporter of the communities of Religious Sisters and Brothers who lived and worked within the City of Adelaide, the list of his influences could continue for the whole of this Newsletter and beyond.

Welcome Monsignor 'Bob', and be assured of our prayers for you as once again you lead us in the Eucharist which has always been at the heart of your life as a priest. Parishioners are welcome to gather for morning tea in the Cathedral Hall after the 11am Mass.

New Cathedral Parish Administrator

It was announced last Tuesday, 7th May, that Bishop Gregory O'Kelly SJ AM, has appointed **Fr. Anthoni Adimai SdM** as Administrator of the Cathedral Parish from Saturday 22nd June. Fr. Anthoni is currently Parish Priest of both Hectorville and Tranmere and comes to the Cathedral having celebrated the 20th anniversary of his ordination.

Fr. Roy John Elavumkal SMM, who has been ministering at Dulwich/Burnside and in the Cathedral, has been appointed as Parish Priest of St Joseph's Parish, Tranmere from Saturday 1st June.

Fr. Joseph Raja George, Assistant Priest at Hectorville, has been appointed as Assistant Priest for the Cathedral Parish from 1st June. He will assume responsibility for the communities of Dulwich and Burnside and be involved in the Cathedral ministry as well.

Fr. Denis Ssemuju, who has been assisting in the Cathedral for the last two months, has been appointed as Assistant Priest to Fr. Anthony Kain at Glenelg, with particular responsibilities at St John the Baptist, Plympton from Saturday 11th May.

We welcome Fr. Anthoni and Fr. Joseph to the Cathedral Parish and pray that they will quickly settle into the life of the community. We thank Fr. Roy and Fr. Denis for their ministry within the Cathedral Parish and wish them well in their new appointments.

Fr Maurice Shinnick will conclude his Cathedral appointment on Friday 21st June.

Procession in Honour of Mary

Parishioners are invited to take part in the 70th Annual Archdiocesan Procession of Mary on Sunday 19th May. It takes place in the South Parklands in Peace Park which is behind Veale Gardens on South Terrace.

Assembly time is 1.30 pm. Please join in with the Adelaide Cathedral Parish. (Each parish and ethnic community has an assembly point clearly marked in the gathering area.) The procession itself starts with the Rosary, Scripture readings and hymns at 2pm. It concludes with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

The theme this year is taken from a new Feast Day of Mary instituted by Pope Francis for the day after Pentecost Sunday: The Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church.
