No Disabled Cathedral Car Parking

From Monday to Friday the disabled carpark will be out of bounds from 8th July through to the end of October for completion of work regarding the new roof on the Diocesan Centre.

The disabled cannot park in front of the side foyer doors of the cathedral as this space will be used for trade vehicles and there is no access at all to the parking area behind the sacristy. Please do make alternate arrangements if you are visiting the Cathedral during these times from July to October 2019.

The reason being that cranes and other heavy vehicles need to have access and they cannot drive through with vehicles being parked in the disabled parking area. Cranes will have to lift material over the area normally reserved for disabled car parking and this will be a risk to both people and their vehicles.

We regret the inconvenience caused during this time and thank you for your cooperation in this regard.
