Dear Sisters and Brothers,

I wish you greetings and best wishes. I write to you with regards to National Vocations Awareness Week which covers the two weekends of **August 6/7 and 13/14**. Together in this time the whole Church in Australia celebrates the unique call and vocation that God has for each of us.

In the first weekend we are reminded that through our Baptisms we are all called uniquely by God. We are called personally but also communally as we become members of the Body of Christ, the Church. Together, with our different gifts, talents and responsibilities we are united in the Holy Spirit to be on the mission of evangelising our world. Monday, August 8th marks the 103rd anniversary of the death of Mary MacKillop and the Feast Day of Australia's first Saint. Canonised by Pope Benedict XVI on 17 October 2010, Saint Mary of the Cross MacKillop's Feast Day will be celebrated not only at schools, parishes and churches across Australia but by communities and individuals worldwide.

Born in Brunswick Street, Fitzroy in Melbourne in 1842, St Mary was the eldest of eight children, the daughter of Scottish-born immigrants Alexander and Flora MacKillop.

At 19, St Mary met Father Julian Tenison Woods, the priest assigned to St Joseph's Church and the Penola Parish. A talented missionary, musician, writer, scientist and lecturer, Fr Julian and St Mary had similar ideas on education and their faith. When he told her he needed help with the religious education of children in the outback, she instantly volunteered and the rest is history.

St Mary died on Sunday, August 8, 1909. Her funeral was held at St Mary's Catholic Church on Miller Street, North Sydney and attended by an enormous crowd.

In June 1995, Mary MacKillop was beatified by Pope St. John Paul II. In February 2010, Pope Benedict XVI recognised MacKillop as a saint. She was canonised 17th October 2010.

The Feast Mass will be celebrated on 8th August at St Francis Xavier Cathedral at the 8am, 12.10pm and 5.45pm Mass.

COVID-19 Protocols Update: 17 June 2022

- If you have tested positive for COVID-19 please follow the instructions as per SA Health in terms of contact tracing and isolating yourself as per government health protocols. **Please stay home and do not attend church services till you have fully recovered.**
- The density requirement has been updated to full capacity in all churches and also includes funerals and weddings.
- Wearing of face-masks is not mandatory in Church but is strongly recommended by the Archbishop. Please carry your own mask if you plan to wear one. This includes all religious except when delivering a sermon.
- Sick and high risk/vulnerable people are requested to stay home and not attend services.
- Hand sanitiser is available at church entrances. Kindly sanitise your hands before entering the church.
- Communion is given only in hands.
- Precious Blood will not be distributed.
- Holy Water is not available at the doors of churches.
- Procession of gifts has resumed.
- Collection plates are to be passed around with minimum contact.
- All surfaces should be cleaned at least daily, with special attention given to frequently touched surfaces.
