REMINDER NOTICE TO ALL PARISHIONERS:

Cathedral Car Park and Staircase Driveway on the Cathedral lawns and Driveway in the Underground Car park

We are still having major challenges with the underground car park on weekends. This is an important REMINDER NOTICE to all our parishioners and visitors. All pedestrians and parents with baby strollers must **ONLY USE** the carpark staircase when entering and exiting the underground carpark. Using the carpark ramp as a pedestrian walkway or for baby strollers is a major safety hazard. Please avoid doing so.

Please do not double park your car in the underground car park driveway. Blocking the safe entry and exit of vehicles during Weekend Masses and is a major safety hazard and the vehicle will be towed away at the owner's cost.

Parking on the driveway of the Cathedral lawns is also prohibited at all times. Both the driveways underground car park and on the lawns) must be free for movement of vehicles at all times.

The car park is under video surveillance at all times to check for unauthorized parking of vehicles.

Please note on weekdays the carpark is only open to parishioners attending Mass from 5-7pm in the evening. Thank you for your cooperation in this regard.

REMINDER NOTICE Working with Children Check Clearance for all Volunteers of the Adelaide Cathedral Parish

It is a legal requirements that all volunteers 14 years and older have a valid Working with Children Check clearance (WWCC) from the Department of Human Services (DHS). Kindly note the following:

- All new applications need to contact their local church representative to lodge their application. Please note the contact details below.
- All existing volunteers that need to renew their clearance can contact the parish office or their local representative to renew your application. Please note: DHS is directly emailing existing clearance holders 9 months prior to expiry requesting a renewal of your clearance.
- All children between the ages of 14-17 years need to apply for a WWCC with signed parental consent on the forms.
- Any volunteer (new or existing) having a valid WWCC clearance associated with another organisation can share a copy of the clearance email from DHS. Please email the details to the parish office to have it associated with the Archdiocese of Adelaide register.
- All altar servers, choir members, youth group core team, readers and ministers at Mass, cleaners, welcomers, bell ringers, sacristans, Legion of Mary core group and general church volunteers needs a valid WWCC to serve in their roles without any exceptions.
- If your clearance has expired you need to first have your clearance renewed before you continue with your ministry.
