Holy Trinity Sunday - Year B

26th May 2024

On the feast of the Most Holy Trinity the church invites us to reflect on the central and most unfathomable mystery of our faith, which she has been sent to announce and make present: the mystery of who God is. In our practice of Christian Life, the Trinity is remembered often in prayer and during the daily routine by every Christian. Each time we make the sign of the cross, as we did at the beginning of this celebration, we say: "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." The Holy Trinity is the mystery of God in himself – a God who is "one but not solitary" as a fourth-century Creed says. Even though we remember the Trinity several times a day, as we invoke its presence before we begin any activity, yet it is difficult to comprehend the full meaning because the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit we invoke constitute a great Mystery. Our God is a Trinity, a God of love and forgiveness. In the Gospel of today Jesus commissions his disciples to carry on his mission to all nations baptising them in the name of the Father, Son and the Holy Spirit and promises to be with them till the end times.

## REMINDER NOTICE Working with Children Check Clearance for all Volunteers of the Adelaide Cathedral Parish

It is a legal requirements that all volunteers 14 years and older have a valid Working with Children Check clearance (WWCC) from the Department of Human Services (DHS). Kindly note the following:

- **All new applications need to contact their local church representative to lodge their application. Please note the contact details below.**
- **All existing volunteers that need to renew their clearance can contact the parish office or their local representative to renew your application. Please note: DHS is directly emailing existing clearance holders 9 months prior to expiry requesting a renewal of your clearance.**
- **All children between the ages of 14-17 years need to apply for a WWCC with signed parental consent on the forms.**
- **Any volunteer (new or existing) having a valid WWCC clearance associated with another organisation can share a copy of the clearance email from DHS. Please email the details to the parish office to have it associated with the Archdiocese of Adelaide register.**
- **All altar servers, choir members, youth group core team, readers and ministers at Mass, cleaners, welcomers, bell ringers, sacristans, Legion of Mary core group and general church volunteers needs a valid WWCC to serve in their roles without any exceptions.**
- **If your clearance has expired you need to first have your clearance renewed before you continue with your ministry.**
