St. Francis Xavier Cathedral will be undergoing a complete re-roofing over the next 2.5 months in different phases (21 October 2024-31 January 2025). We request all parishioners to please note this information when visiting the Cathedral during this time. **Areas in the church will be cordoned off over different periods of time due to dust falling from the ceiling. Keeping in mind the safety of all our Parishioners, we request you to kindly avoid these areas at all times. If you need to wear a mask when attending Mass on weekdays, please do so.** We request you to please adhere to all safety protocols in place and any requests made by staff when visiting the Cathedral during this period of time. Please be aware of the external scaffolding when entering and exiting the Cathedral. **Please DO NOT PARK your vehicles during this period of time on the driveway next to the Cathedral lawns and observe the No-Parking and Danger Signs installed. Children should not be allowed to play on the lawns and must be accompanied by a parent/adult at all times. The Handicap parking spot is also not available till further notice. Thank you for your cooperation in this regard.**

Death of David Shinnick OAM

We regret to announce the death of David Shinnick OAM, brother of Fr. Maurice Shinnick, former Administrator of the Adelaide Cathedral Parish. David was a leading layman for many years in the Archdiocese of Adelaide and Director of the Diocesan Pastoral Renewal, initiated by Archbishop James Gleeson. He was one of the driving forces behind the Catholic Church's international aid and development agency in Australia, known today as Caritas Australia. Pope John Paul II conferred on David Shinnick the honour of Knight of St Sylvester (KSS) in 1981, and in 1996, David was awarded the Order of Australia Medal (OAM) for services to Church and Community. We offer our prayers and deepest sympathy to Fr Maurice and his family. May David's soul rest in peace. **A mass is being offered for David on Saturday 16th November at 6pm at the Cathedral. All are welcome.**

Adelaide Cathedral Parish School Aged Sacramental Program 2025

REMINDER NOTICE TO ALL PARISHIONERS:

Cathedral Car Park and Staircase Driveway on the Cathedral lawns and Driveway in the Underground Car park

This is a REMINDER NOTICE to all parishioners and visitors when using the underground carpark. All pedestrians and parents with baby strollers must ONLY USE the carpark staircase when entering and exiting the underground carpark. Using the carpark ramp as a pedestrian walkway or for baby strollers is a major safety hazard. Please avoid doing so. The underground carpark and the Cathedral lawns are monitored with CCTV cameras at all times.

Please do not double park your car in the underground car park driveway. Blocking the entry and exit of vehicles during is a major safety hazard and the vehicle will be towed away at the owner’s cost and fined.

Parking on the driveway of the Cathedral lawns is also prohibited. Both the driveways (underground car park and on the lawns) must be free for movement of vehicles at all times. Thank you for your cooperation.

Please note the Cathedral is an active construction site on weekdays till further notice due to repairs being conducted so please follow the parking instructions of staff when requested.
